#### **PURPOSE**

This formalizes the policy and procedure (P&P) of the department on establishing guidelines to seek approval and funding in the event there is a request to increase maintenance efforts from seasonal to year-round.

The purpose of this P&P is to assure any Right-of-Way/Roadway that is currently maintained seasonally will not receive year-round maintenance until such time funding has been provided and is in place.

## **POLICY**

The department will not assume any additional maintenance and operations (M&O) responsibilities for any Right-of-Way/Roadway without written approval by the Deputy Commissioner and required funding has been appropriated. All proposed additional maintenance costs (capital and operating) will be calculated by roadway feature to determine an overall cost per lane mile effort of additional management/maintenance.

Features to be considered are:

- Width of Right-of-Way
- Length of Right-of-Way
- Average Annual Daily Traffic
- Divided Road Centerline
- Undivided Road Centerline
- Surface
  - Asphalt
  - Gravel
- Shoulder
  - Asphalt
  - Gravel
- Bridges
- Barriers

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- Guardrail
- Other
- Drainage
  - Surface
  - o Underground
- Illumination/Reflectors
- Turnouts
- Facilities
- Signs and Signals
- Markings
- Utilities
  - o Above ground
  - Underground
- Vegetation Control
- Environmental Issues

Authority for this P&P will not be delegated and cannot be performed by a person in a temporary or acting capacity.

# **PROCEDURE**

- After the request for increased services comes to a region from the petitioner, a memo of explanation will be sent to the Deputy Commissioner through the Administrative Services Director notifying them and requesting the authority to proceed.
- Upon approval from the Deputy Commissioner, establish open communication with the affected stakeholders to discuss the merits of the request.
- Discuss the requested services, needs, and possible sources for the cost of the additional services to be provided with those affected.
- Develop an operation and capital cost estimate by roadway feature establishing an overall cost per lane mile for the additional services.
- By memo with documentation, through the Administrative Services Director, send the cost estimate to the Deputy Commissioner. If approved, the Administrative Services Director will request through the normal annual budget process an incremental increase to the affected Result Delivery Unit (RDU).
- No additional services will be performed until funding is appropriated and in place.

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Once approved by the Deputy Commissioner, the Director of Statewide Program Development shall be notified by memo from the accepting Regional Director. The memo will explain the additional M&O responsibilities and the location by mile point of Right-of-Way/Roadway added to the department responsibilities for inclusion into the Highway Analysis System (HAS) for tracking and statistical purposes.
