PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to define responsibility for installation and maintenance of stormwater inlet controls, such as oil/water separators (OWS). The controls will be used to manage stormwater runoff in a manner that reduces pollutants in stormwater discharges at the Anchorage and Fairbanks International Airports.

POLICY

It is AIAS policy to install OWS or have them installed where prescribed by each airport's stormwater pollution prevention plan or as mandated by local, state or federal requirements.

It is AIAS policy that tenants pay all costs necessary to install, operate and maintain OWS required to treat surface runoff water from their leased area.

AIAS will install, operate and maintain OWS required to treat surface runoff water from common-use areas or areas of the airport not under lease.

Each airport will develop procedures in response to unique climatological and facility differences, specifics of the airport's stormwater pollution prevention plan and other airport-specific elements.
