



### See Alaska Pass Rules and Conditions

The See Alaska Pass is a one way pass that may be used in either a north or a southbound direction and is available to walk on passengers. It allows travelers the opportunity to stop at multiple ports while traveling the Inside Passage to or from Prince Rupert and Haines or Skagway in the North Lynn Canal. The **See Alaska Pass** offers passengers the chance to make up to three stops, exploring the communities of Ketchikan, Wrangell, Petersburg, Sitka, Juneau, Haines or Skagway for the pass price of \$160, a savings of up to 25%!

#### Qualifying Conditions-

- ✓ The **See Alaska Pass** applies to full price adult and children's passenger fares only. Food, beverages and all other amenities are charged at normal rates. No discount is offered for vehicles or cabins. No additional discounts are available to the pass price of \$160-adults and \$80-children.
- ✓ Travel utilizing the **See Alaska Pass** must either initiate in Prince Rupert, BC, terminating in either Haines or Skagway, Alaska OR initiate in either Haines or Skagway, Alaska terminating in Prince Rupert, BC. Additional port stops can only include the communities of Ketchikan, Wrangell, Petersburg, Sitka, Juneau, and Haines or Skagway.
- ✓ The **See Alaska Pass** must be utilized in a continuous North or Southbound route.
- ✓ Once **The See Alaska Pass** is purchased it is valid for travel throughout the entire promotional period on up to four city pairs in the direction of travel. All eligible travel must be completed between May 1<sup>st</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
- ✓ The **See Alaska Pass** is purchased as a pass with a cash value. The pass can then be applied to an itinerary when travel is confirmed. The pass can be purchased through our online reservations system or by calling our reservations center at 1-800-642-0066. Passes can also be purchased at any AMHS terminal or through your local travel agent.

#### Payments/Refunds-

1. The **See Alaska Pass** is sold separately from travel and although travel need not be booked when the pass is purchased once travel is confirmed all standard AMHS policies and procedures apply.
2. The **See Alaska Pass** is non-refundable after travel is initiated
3. Reservations booked in advance must be paid by their due date to be confirmed. Payments may be made online, in person or via phone.
4. Those passengers already holding tickets or who made earlier payment may use the pass as payment for the booked travel and be due a refund of excess payment.

5. Walk-ons may purchase a **See Alaska Pass** at the time of departure based on space availability. Advance reservations are recommended.
6. Refunds for cancellations 15 or more days prior will receive full refunds, less FCH (change fee) if applicable. Refunds for cancellations 14 days or less, prior to sailing, will incur our standard 15% cancellation penalty.
