Construction Update – ANC John Johansen

- Runway 7R Upgrade/Reconstruction
 - •Phase 1, is ahead of schedule with completion expected by Sept 15.
 - •Phase 2, and the Extension of Runway 7R are scheduled for 2011.
- North Terminal
 - Gate N8 Aircraft Parking Apron Reconstruction is underway and will be complete this summer.
 - •Replacement of Jet Bridges at North Terminal Gates N4 and N6 is to begin later this summer with completion by end of year.
 - •Construction of the Airport Communications Center and Badge Office to begin later this summer with early 2011 completion.



Construction Update – LHD John Johansen

- Lakeshore Drive Shoulder Widening almost complete.
- •LHD Strip Improvements (Taxiway Lighting and Access Control Gates) to be constructed this fall.
- •Bank Stabilization Project Phase 1 (West side of Commercial Finger and North Shore of Lake Spenard) to begin this fall with most of work next summer.



Concession Update Debbie Herrick

- Build-out of Humpy's Restaurant has begun. The scheduled opening date is July 18th.
- Norton Sound Seafood House is still in the building permit process and the anticipated opening date has been pushed to mid-September.
- Landside Food and Beverage Request for Proposals closed on Monday, June 7th. Expect to issue a Notice of Intent to Award by the end of next week.
- Finalizing a concession agreement to provide shipping services and the sale and shipping of frozen seafood on the landside across from the screening area.






ANC FY06-FY10 YTD Reported Monthly Combined Cargo-Pax Landings Count As of April 30, 2010






ANC FY06 - FY10 YTD Monthly Reported Combined Cargo - Pax CMGTW Projected Through May 30, 2010

Cost Containment Trudy Wassel

- FY10 ANCHORAGE AIRPORT OPERATING BUDGET
 - \$50,245.9 (\$3,921.4 Cost Containment)
 - 390 Positions (59 vacancies- 15% as of 1 June)
- FY11 ANCHORAGE AIRPORT OPERATING BUDGET
 - \$50,245.9 + \$1,509.3 (Bargaining Unit Health Care Increases)
 - + \$967.3 Reinstate Cost Containment =
 - \$52,722.5 FY11 Operating Budget (\$2,954.1 Cost Containment)



Cost Containment Trudy Wassel

- (5) Positions were deleted in the FY11 Budget Process.
 - 2 Airport Screening Law Enforcement Officers (LEO)
 Funded with Federal Authority
 - -- 1 Environmental Impact Analyst. Position vacant since 2007. IARF funded
 - -- Administrative Clerk II. Position vacant since 2007. IARF funded
 - 1 Equipment Operations Analyst. Position vacant since 2006.
 IARF funded



. 24 Positions being hired

- Anchorage Airport Chief Engineer hired in April 2010
- Environmental Program Specialist III hired and will start in July
- Currently recruiting for (2) Engineer III
- The interviews/testing has started (recruitment closed) for
- (6) Police & Fire Officers
- (7) Equipment Operators were hired in May/June; hired (1) Lead Auto Mechanic in June; interviews will be starting for (1) Airfield Maintenance Assistant Manager
- (3) Environmental Services (custodians) hired in May; interviewing now for (2) Building Maintenance Specialists

- Information Officer II (Communications Manager)




GovDelivery Trudy Wassel
