Alaska VBOC Highlights & Overview

2023- Business Impact NW was selected as Center of Excellence and awarded host of the new Alaska VBOC

- Only 28 VBOC's nationally
- Alaska VBOC was chosen as one of only 6 centers selected

Our outreach centers empower active-duty service members, National Guard & Reserve Component members, members of the Coast Guard, transitioning Service Members, Veterans of all eras, Military Spouse to include Gold Star Spouses who are thinking about starting, purchasing, or growing a small business.

We offer training opportunities, one on one coaching, assistance with business plan development, referrals to resource partners, and networking events throughout all of Alaska. While we cover all of Alaska virtually, we do have on-site locations in Anchorage and Fairbanks.



Alaska VBOC Highlights & Overview

- Since opening on May 1^a, the VBOC Team has conducted over 26 Boots to Business classes, with over 300 attendees
- Out of these attendees, we have tracked 54 jobs created/retained, and 3 new business start ups
- Additionally, VBOC has provided over 43 business advising sessions

- Offered quarterly

- Available for all military connected individuals
- Highlights all entrepreneurs in the Region X VBOC system



IMPACT Pitch

- Annual Pitch Competition, offered on site and virtually to accommodate business owners needs
- Entrepreneurs develop business plans, pitch skills, and marketing tactics
- Present to panels, advancing to different levels
- Winners awarded in Best Start-up Business, Best Early-Stage Business, Best Established
- Business, and Audience Favorite
