## PURPOSE

This formalizes the policy and procedure (P&P) of the department to provide guidelines on movies shown onboard Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) vessels in public areas.

## POLICY

It is the policy of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) that all movies which are shown in public areas onboard AMHS vessels are for the entertainment of the passengers.

Due to copyright laws, movies shown will be limited to those on which royalties have been paid, and which have been obtained from licensed video movie dealers or those for which no royalty is required.

## PROCEDURE

Movies which are shown in the public areas onboard AMHS vessels may be available to the crew as well as the passengers for viewing. Viewing by crew members must be scheduled to be compatible with the passengers.

During those hours when the Purser is off duty, a designated member of the ship crew shall have access to the film library for the purpose of showing movies during the evening.

To accommodate those passengers that use the forward lounge for sleeping, viewing will not be shown in that area after 10:00p.m.
