## PURPOSE

To establish guidelines for replacement of state owned equipment.

## POLICY

It is the policy of the department that vehicles and equipment be replaced when they are at the end of their economic life, or are no longer safe or reliable to perform their intended function. Economic life is that point where the cost to continue to use the unit (including time loss to users (downtime), cost of repairs and maintenance, and other costs), exceeds the cost of replacement and maintenance of another unit.

It is the responsibility of the Statewide Equipment Fleet to establish replacement criteria guidelines for use in determining the actual time of replacement for the various classes of vehicles and equipment.
