Fairbanks International Airport management believes that safety is a core value and is committed to the prevention of incidents and accidents that may negatively impact life or safety while protecting property and the environment.

FAI believes that, through proactive identification and mitigation of hazards, all accidents are preventable. We recognize that an effective Safety Management System (SMS) is crucial in achieving our goals and objectives and attaining the highest levels of safety performance.

Safety is everyone's responsibility and the active participation of all airport and tenant employees, regardless of job title, is crucial to the success of the SMS. As such, FAI is committed to:

- >Providing the safest possible work and travel environments.
- ➤ Promoting a culture of safety across all airport operations and encouraging all staff, stakeholders and visitors to report all safety concerns, hazards and incidents.
- Ensuring that no action will be taken against any airport staff, stakeholder or visitor who reports a safety concern unless such disclosure indicates, beyond any reasonable doubt, an illegal act, gross negligence or a deliberate or willful disregard of regulations, policies or procedures.
- ➤ Providing the resources and training necessary to address safety issues and continuously improve safety performance.
- Clearly defining for all staff, their accountabilities and responsibilities in achieving the highest level of safety performance and the performance of our SMS.
- Complying with, at a minimum and wherever possible exceeding, legislative and regulatory requirements.
