Anchorage Airport Update February 2018

1. LHD Seaplane Base Tiedown Regulations:

- a) The public comment period closed January 19, 2018 for the proposed regulation changes. Additional public notice will occur when the department makes a determination on the next phase of the project. Answers to questions that were posed during the comment period, to include the December 12, 2017 public meeting, have been posted on the LHD website at http://dot.alaska.gov/anc/business/generalAviation/.
- 2. Lake Hood Seaplane Base Frozen Lakes: Winter operations are in effect. Please stay off the ice unless accessing or operating aircraft. The frozen lakes remain restricted active runway surfaces all winter long for ski operations. For further information please contact the Lake Hood Office at 907-266-2410.

3. Terminal Concessions:

- a) The Pork and Pickle restaurant will soon be available to serve the public pre-security in conjunction with the current post security offerings. Construction of the pre-security location will begin in the spring with estimated completion by late spring/early summer.
- b) Construction of a new ice cream venue, Crème, located both pre and post security, will begin shortly with estimated completion by late spring/early summer.
- **4. ANC Runway 15/33 Rehabilitation Project:** The project will rehabilitate and widen RW 15/33 (the north/south runway), and update taxiway geometry to meet FAA standards through the summers of 2018 and 2019. The runway will be partially closed during the 2018 summer and fully closed during the 2019 summer. Both construction seasons will require heavier cargo aircraft to be shifted to the east-west runways. 2019 summer construction will require *all* aircraft to utilize the east-west runways.
- **5.** Anchorage Transportation Fair: Airport construction projects will be represented at the fair being held February 8th from 3-7pm at the Alaska Airlines Center Auxiliary, UAA, 3550 Providence Drive. <u>Anchoragetranspofair.blogspot.com/.</u>
